

STUDENT SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2021/2022

ALL STUDENT NEEDS TO BRING:

- 1 NIV Bible (may be purchased from the office) (grades 1-12 only)
 - NIV Life Application Study Bible, Personal Size (recommended 7-12)
- All elementary students & MS/HS enrolled in a physical education class- a pair of gym shoes to be left at school. (*Preschool & Kindergarten shoes w/Velcro or bungee cord*)
- All elementary students- 1 paint t-shirt in a gallon baggie with your name for art class
- All elementary students headphones in a gallon baggie with your name for tech class
- 1 Backpack w/ name (elementary only)
- 1 lunch box w/ name (elementary only)
- Water bottle (with a spout or something that won't spill when open but not in use)
- Hot lunch items:
 - K-2 (2) packages of paper plates
 - 3-6- (2) packages of plastic spoons

5th & 6th Grade

- 1 full-size zippered nylon 3 ring binder to hold folders
- 4 pocket folders (2 that fit inside binder)
- 1 assignment notebook (checkbook size is too small)
- package of thin whiteboard black markers
- 2 composition notebooks
- 1 one-subject spiral notebook
- pencils
- scissors
- colored pencils or markers
- **Wish list items:** clear cups, ziplock baggies (any size), prize box items, gel pens, dry erase color markers

7th – 12th Grades

- 1 Bible Journal
- College ruled lined paper (needed for all homework assignments, more lined paper may be needed throughout the year).
- Pens and Pencils
- Algebra 2 & Pre-Calc: graphing calculator (TI-84 preferred), 3 ring binder
- Physics, Chemistry, Physical Science: Scientific calculator, 3 ring binder
- All other 7 – 12th grade Math classes: Scientific Calculator (graphing calculator optional), 3 ring binder
- For AP U.S. History: 3 ring binder (2"-2.5" should be sufficient) for handouts (unit outlines, supplemental readings, etc.). Dividers for the binder will be helpful in keeping content organized but aren't required. Notebook for reading notes.
- Middle/high school students must have a book protector/jacket for each of their textbooks (paper bags work great).
- Students would also benefit from a planner/ assignment notebook, a notebook for each class, or a folder per class for organization purposes.
- **Wish list items:** dry erase markers, lined paper, graph paper
